



Pooch Pass Registration Form

General Requirements

All dog owners must be residents of the Great Neck Park District, must register their dog(s), and obtain an annual Pooch Pass from the Great Neck House. Owners must sign a waiver and release form, their dogs must be licensed, and proof of vaccination for rabies and Bordetella must be submitted with applications. Dogs must be at least 4 months of age. No commercial use of the dog park will be permitted.

Dog Park Rules

- Dogs must be leashed prior to entering and upon leaving the dog park.
- Be sure that gates are always closed and locked.
- Unsupervised children under 12 years of age are not permitted in the dog run.
- The dog park is open daily from 9 a.m. to sunset.
- No smoking or eating in the dog park.
- There is a limit of 2 dogs per person per visit.
- Dogs shall not be left unattended and shall not be out of sight range.
- Dogs must be under voice command.
- There are areas designated for small and large dogs. Any dog more than 30 pounds shall be deemed to be a large dog.
- Dogs that exhibit aggressive behavior must be removed from the park immediately.
- Dogs that exhibit incessant barking must be removed from the park immediately.
- Dogs in heat are not permitted.
- Dogs, owners, and users creating disturbances or violating posted rules must leave the dog park.
- Owners must always clean up after their dog(s).
- Owners must fill any holes created by their dog(s).

Dog Park Waiver & Release

You are solely responsible for supervising any dog you bring into Park District facilities, and determining whether or not use of, and activity at, Park District facility is appropriate for you and your dog. You and others who accompany you are participating in this activity at your and their own risk (and risk of your dog). Dogs and permit holders of varying degrees of skill, training, and experience use this facility.

You are solely responsible for determining if you and/or your dog are physically fit and/or adequately skilled to use this facility. It is always advisable, especially if you or your dog is pregnant, disabled in any way, or recently suffered an illness, injury, or impairment, to consult a physician or veterinarian before undertaking any dog training or exercise activity.

When this Waiver & Release refers to "your dog," "my dog," or the "owner" of a dog, it includes you, whether or not you are the legal owner of the dog because you are the person responsible for the dog while using this facility.

WARNING OF RISK

Dog activities are intended to provide a fun and rewarding experience for a dog and its owner/handler. However, despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury, including death, to the dog, its owner/handler, or other persons/animals. Dogs are pack animals and when "off lead" even the best-trained dogs will act instinctively. Not all hazards and dangers associated with dog activities can be foreseen. Certain inherent risks include the propensity of any dog to behave in dangerous ways that may result in injury to you, another person or dog. Other risks include, but are not limited to, the inexperience, negligence or irresponsibility of a dog owner/handler, the inability to predict a dog's reaction to sound, movements, objects, persons, or other animals; and actions by the dog due to fright, anger, stress, insect bites, or natural reactions such as jumping, pulling, resisting and biting. Other risks include the hazards associated with environmental and traffic conditions, acts of God, inclement weather, slip and falls, premises defects, equipment failure, failure in instruction/supervision, and all other circumstances inherent to dog and/or outdoor activities.

If you attempt to break up a dog fight or restrain a dog, including but not limited to your dog, you may be attacked and severely mauled by your dog or the other dog, or attacked dog's owner/handler. You understand that the Great Neck Park District does not and cannot guarantee safety for you or your dog.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

Please read this form carefully. In consideration for permission to use this facility, you expressly assume the risk and legal liability, and waive and release all claims for injuries associated with use of this facility and surrounding area. You hereby represent the Park District as follows:

I recognize and acknowledge that use of this facility and the surrounding area are for dog activities and participating in dog activities entails certain risks of damage, loss or injury to animals, persons or property (including to me, other persons, my dog, or other dogs or animals), and I voluntarily agree to assume the full risk of and responsibility for any injuries, damages, loss, liability, costs and expenses, regardless of severity, extent or amount, that (a) I, my dog, or any other person accompanying me might sustain or incur as a result of my presence in this facility and surrounding area or (b) any other person or animal might sustain as a result of my or my dog's actions or conduct in connection with or arising out of my presence or my dog's presence in this facility and surrounding area or my participating in any and all activities connected with or associated with use of this facility and surrounding area.

I do hereby agree to waive, relinquish, release and forever discharge (a) the Great Neck Park District and its elected officials, officers, directors, employees and agents, and (b) any volunteer assisting or working on behalf of the Park District or any of its elected officials, officers, directors, employees or agents from any and all claims or causes of action for damages, injury, loss, liability or expenses that I may now have or which may accrue hereafter to me or any other persons claiming through my or on my behalf and arising out of, connected with, or in any way associated with use of this facility and surrounding area by me or my dog.

I further agree to indemnify and hold harmless and defend (a) the Park District and its elected officials, officers, directors, employees and agents, and (b) any volunteer assisting or working on behalf of the Park District or any of its elected officials, officers, directors, employees or agents from and against any and all losses, claims, damages, liabilities, causes of action and expenses (including but not limited to court costs and attorney fees) occurring, growing out of, incident to, or resulting directly or indirectly from my or my dog's use of this facility and surrounding area, including without limitation and losses, claims, damages, liabilities, cause of actions and expenses on account of personal injury to or death of any person or animal, or damages to property of any person or entity (including but not limited to the Park District).

I HAVE READ AND FULLY UNDERSTAND THE ABOVE IMPORTANT INFORMATION, WARNING OF RISK, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND RULES FOR USE OF THE DOG PARK.
